Notice is given in terms of Regulation 41(2) of GNR 326 as Amended (07 April 2017) published under section 24 and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) for submission of applications for Environmental Authorisations (EA) in respect of activities identified in terms of GNR 327 as Amended (7 April 2017).

## BACKGROUND AND LOCATION

Eskom Holdings SOC Limited (Eskom) proposes to construct a make-up and raw water supply pipeline at the Medupi Coal Fired Power Station on farms Naauw Ontkopen 509 LQ, Portion 0 and Kuipersbult 511 LQ, Portion 0, in Lephalale, Ward 2, Lephalale Local Municipality, Limpopo. Medupi Power Station is being constructed with installation of Flue Gas Desulphurisation (FGD) system, to manage sulphur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) emissions, to each of the six 800 MegaWatt (MW) coal fired steam electricity generating units. The FGD Project will result in the addition of wet limestone open spray tower FGD systems to each of the units. To support the FGD operation, additional raw water is required, and this water will be supplied from the Mokolo Crocodile Water Augmentation Project – Phase 2 (MCWAP-2). The proposed pipeline requires an environmental authorisation (EA) in terms of NEMA and the associated Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 as amended. Due to the nature of the project thresholds, Eskom is required to follow a Basic Assessment (BA) process to acquire environmental approval prior to the commencement of the Proposed Project.
