AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEPTUNE-POSEIDON 400Kv POWERLINE, WITHIN BUFFALO CITY, NQUSHWA, NKONKOBÉ, NXUBA AND BLUE CRANE ROUTE LOCAL MUNICIPALITIES, EASTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 11 July 2012; the amendment issued on 05 August 2013 and your application for amendment to the EA received by this Department on 05 April 2017 refer.

With reference to the abovementioned letter for the extension of the EA. Please be advised that the Department has decided to grant an extension of the EA issued on 11 July 2012.

The extension is subject to the following conditions:

- The activity must commence within a period of five (05) years from the date of expiry of the EA issued on 11 July 2012, expiring on 11 July 2017, now extended to 11 July 2022. If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.
- This correspondence is only for the extension of the validity period as stated herein above and all conditions set out in the Environmental Authorisation dated 11 July 2012 remain unchanged and must be adhered to.

This letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 11 July 2012.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the Department's decision in respect of the amendment made as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the National Appeals Regulations, 2014.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of Government Notice No. R.993, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed.

An appellant must submit an appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the competent authority.
