A 3-year period is not sufficient for the implantation/commencement of this project. Eskom needs to negotiate with affected landowners, and finalize the construction Environmental Management Programme with input from the specialists once the final walk down of the approved powerline route is undertaken. This will take time in terms of appointments, compilation, and implementation, and therefore additional time is required. The additional time is also required to ensure that all relevant permits are in place in order for construction to commence.
